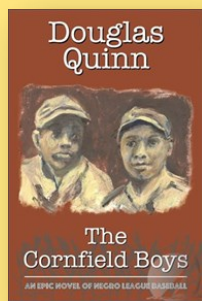

Black History Month Events

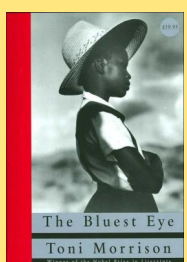
For the Love of the Game: Local Legends of Baseball
